Jefferson County, Colo. – Colorado’s Donnell-Kay Foundation has developed a website, www.crumblingclassrooms.com to highlight the urgent construction needs facing all Colorado public school districts. A comprehensive study commissioned by the foundation estimates current construction and maintenance needs of the state’s 18 public school districts at between \$5.7 billion and \$10 billion.

In Jefferson County, Colorado’s largest public school district, the review identified a \$577-million backlog of maintenance needs over and above the \$324-million bond issue recently approved by voters. The report also found an additional \$444 million needed for lower priority capital needs such as security upgrades, roof repairs, ventilation renovation, fire and security alarms, handicap accessibility and permanent buildings for the district’s preschool program.
